Who We Are:

 - o Program understanding and the ability to communicate such to farm staff
 - o On Farm Training of Barricade™ vaccine intranasal administration
 - Diagnostic sample collection and submission, including nasal wash and IgA
 ELISA to quantify mucosal immune response
 - o Evaluate & grade Barricade™ vaccinated population using necropsy and subjective lung scoring methodology
 - o In addition to intranasal administration, the PM may also evaluate needle-free administration of Barricade™ vaccine using proprietary transdermal equipment
 - o Regular communication with customer veterinary & production staff
- PM will present a summary of results and recommendations to a group of leading swine veterinarians
