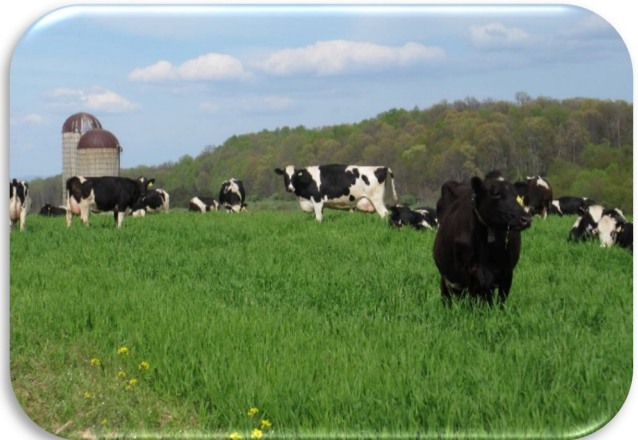


Colebelle Farm

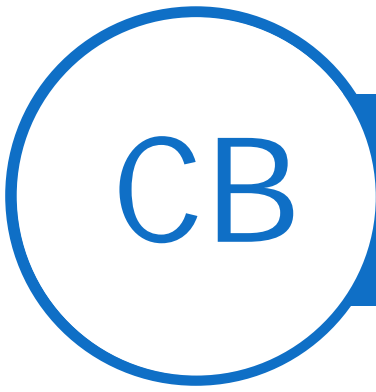
120 milking cows and associated young stock. The herd is recognized for the high quality of milk that it produces and averages around 75 lbs of milk per day.
