

The International Stockmen's Educational Foundation (ISEF) will host the 2021 International Livestock Congress (ILC) as a virtual even on March 2-4, and the online program will focus on Pandemic-Induced Adjustments in the Beef Industry. The 2021 International Livestock Congress will be the 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the ILC addressing the critical issues facing our meat and livestock industries and this is the first year the ILC will be conducted in an online-format.
