Application and Instructions

Much like the beautiful flowers in her gardens, Pamela's life was full of colleagues whose careers blossomed through her loving support. Inspired by this legacy, the Pamela J. Byrd Memorial Scholarship has been established to provide students in the animal feed and nutrition industry with funding to pursue their educational dreams. Pamela's generous spirit lives on through this opportunity to cultivate the future of others.

You must meet the following eligibility requirements to apply for the Pamela J. Byrd Memorial Scholarship:

1. Applicants must be a currently enrolled college student studying Agriculture, with a preference for students majoring in Animal Sciences.
2. Applicants must have achieved the minimum "academic rank" of sophomore in college.
3. All applications and attached documents must be submitted electronically in Word or PDF format.

When applying for the Pamela J. Byrd Memorial Scholarship, please submit the following four items:

- **Completed Application Form**
- **Personal statement including your post-secondary goals and aspirations, key accomplishments, and community service and volunteer work performed.**
- **A one-page letter of support from an academic advisor, guidance counselor, teacher, community leader, or employer. The letter of recommendation cannot be from a family member.**
- **A current transcript of your grades from both high school and college. Transcripts can be unofficial, but official transcripts will be requested if selected as a recipient.**

The Selection Committee may choose to interview finalists. Interviews will be held during the evening at a date and time determined by the Selection Committee and agreeable to the applicant. Winning recipients will be notified by April 1st.

The Pamela J. Byrd Memorial Scholarship will be granting \$5,000 total in scholarships. The distribution of funds will be determined upon award selection and may be provided directly to the student or to their enrolled institution, depending on the final decision of the Selection Committee. Scholarship funds will be released once proof of enrollment is provided.
