



Summer Internship Program: This is a paid dairy farm internship available to highschool graduates, college students and college graduates. While preference currently enrolled in or recent graduates of an Agriculture Sciences, Animal Sciences or Agronomy related degree, we do welcome all applicants with an enthusiastic work ethic and eagerness to learn.

About: Adirondack Farms is a multi-site dairy with locations in Peru, NY and Beekmantown, NY where interns have the opportunity to learn and explore various aspects of a dairy farm business. The farm utilizes technology in various parts of the business to efficiently operate in facilities that range from traditional to modern, the crop team strives for high forage quality utilizing techniques that are environmentally conscious and the farm aims to be team, culture and community focused. Possible areas of concentration include calf & heifer management, herd health, finance, crops & mechanics, outreach & social media, maintenance and reproduction.

Expectations: Every intern will help day to day with tasks and by the end of the internship we hope they will assume responsibility of certain tasks. To recap the internship experience we hope to have each intern report or present about their summer and special project.

Pay & Housing: Interns typically have 1-2 days off and can work up to 60hrs a week depending on area of concentration. Interns are paid a minimum of \$15 an hour and the internship can be extended past 10 weeks. If the intern does not live within comminuting distance, housing accommodations will be made and paid for by the farm.
